

## HIGHWOOD PUBLIC LIBRARY FINANCE COMMITTEE AGENDA Tuesday December 9, 2020 5:30 p.m. Highwood Public Library

1. Call to order: 5:30 p.m.

2. Roll call: President, Lucy Hospodarsky; Treasurer, Nora Loredo; Director, Carmen Patlan

3. Public comment from the floor: None

- 4. Review of the FY21 6-month expenditures against budget. The following observations were made:
  - The tax revenue collections to date are 96%. Although the last installment date has passed, we may continue to see receipts coming through.
  - We also have 100% shortfall in two other revenue collections due to the COVID-19 closure Meeting Room and Copier fees.
  - The total shortfall from above is ~\$15,600
  - There are new sources of revenue that can cover the above revenue stream interruptions, all or in part, should they continue through the next 6 months:

Grant	Amount
Mano a mano COVID prevention	10,000
Rem'g amts in Rails Census grant	3,000
Latino Heritage Endowment Fund	10,000
Total	23,000

- The \$23,000 grants would comfortably cover a worst case scenario shortfall. There would be at least \$7,400 remaining to be used for operating expenses.
- Traditionally, the library operates on a balance budget, and has not in the past fallen short of meeting its budgeted expenses. The COVID-19 shut down has affected property tax collections and our ability to charge fees that we otherwise would have collected.
- 5. The purpose of this mid-year review is to understand if certain expenses need to be curtailed as a result of shortfalls. The Finance Committee concludes that we can continue to spend the budgeted amounts, and have an additional \$7,400 to spend as needed.
- 6. Motion to approve staff bonuses not to exceed 3,000 above the already budgeted amount is approved.
